
Theater Blast Kills 5 In Mekong Delta Town

SAIGON, South Vietnam, June 13 (Reuters) — Five people died and 20 were injured when an explosion rocked an outdoor movie theater in the Mekong Delta province of An Xuyen, the South Vietnamese command said today. A spokesman said that five of the injured were policemen.

Officials attributed the blast to "Communist terrorists."

In the northern province of Quang Nam, two children died and six were injured when they detonated a hand-grenade boobytrap while gathering wood, the spokesman said.

In the central coastal province of Ninh Thuan, guerrillas destroyed two railway bridges yesterday.

Blasts at Cambodia Airport Kill Two and Ravage Area

PHNOM PENH, Cambodia, June 13 (UPI)—Ammunition being loaded into an armed cargo plane exploded today, killing two men, destroying the plane and touching off further explosions and fire that ravaged an airfield in the western provincial capital of Battambang.

There were conflicting reports about the cause of the initial explosion.

The Cambodian high command's spokesman, Col. Am Rong, said he understood that guerrilla shellfire struck near the plane, a C-47, and ignited ammunition ready for loading.

Newsmen who went to the airfield said officers there had told them that the explosion was an accident.
