# Cambodia Bombing

Phnom Penh

American planes yesterday repeatedly attacked rebel forces advancing toward the Cambodian capital from the north on Highways 5 and 6.

Government troops were seen on Highway 6 and American F-4 Phantom jets were visible from the capital as they bombed and strafed rebel positions just north of the town of Battley.

Government troops fell back to Battley on Tuesday, drawing a defensive line at a bridge one mile north of the town. But since then, the rebels have surrounded the town. The rebel forces advanced to Battley after capturing the town of Phnom Penh on June 28.

# Hai Phong De-Mined

A U.S. minesweeping task force has completed opening North Vietnam's port of Hai Phong and will turn its attention to the port of Vinh south of Hai Phong, the Defense Department said yesterday.

The task force has also cleared two lesser ports in the vicinity of Hai Phong and will sweep three lesser ports in the Vinh area, a spokesman said.
