The four signers of the

Vietnam cease-fire agree-ment — the U.S., North Viet-nam, South Vietnam and the Viet Cong — must give for-mal assent to Iran's joining the International Commis-sion of Control and Supports sion of Control and Supervision.

Acceptance of Iran would end a heetic diplomatic ef-fort, conducted by the U.S. in great secrecy, to find a replacement for Canada, which formally withdrew from the commission yesterday.
