Colonel Guy Files for A Divorce

Tucson, Ariz.

Air Force Colonel Theodore Guy, a former prisoner of war who leveled charges against eight fellow POWs earlier this year, has filed for divorce.

The petition, filed jointly by Guy and his wife under Arizona's no-fault divorce law, says the action stems from "unhappy differences" between them.

The action was filed in Superior Court on Thursday, one day before the Guys' 22nd wedding anniversary. They have three children, ranging in age from 16 to 20.

Guy, 42, was shot down over Laos March 22, 1968, and returned home after the Vietnam cease-fire was signed.

His charges against the fellow POWs included collaboration with the enemy. They were dropped later by the Army and the Marine Corps. One of the eight committed suicide.
