Tho Says U.S. Interfering

Paris

North Vietnamese politburo member Le Duc Tho said yesterday the U.S. is still interfering in the internal affairs of South Vietnam to prevent the consolidation of the Viet Cong regime in Communist-controlled areas.

Tho, who conferred last

Thursday with Secretary of State Henry A. Kissinger on the continuing cease-fire violations, said in a French television interview that the U.S. has no choice but to recognize the existence of two rival regimes, two armies and two zones of control in South Vietnam.

Tho gave no details of his

talks with Kissinger, nor did he say how the U.S. was interfering in South Vietnam.
