

Hanoi OKs Release of U.S. Dead

North Vietnam has agreed to allow U.S. officers to visit Hanoi Wednesday to recover the bodies of 12 Americans killed during bombing raids, a North Vietnamese spokesman said today.

The spokesman said Hanoi had made the offer "in a spirit of respect and . . . humanitarianism."

The spokesman said all 12 of the U.S. servicemen had died after being captured by North Vietnamese forces.

He did not name the men, but said they were buried in the Gia Lam area of Hanoi, just north of the Red river near the city's civilian airport.
