Vietcong Demand That Ford Cease All U.S. Aid to Saigon

PARIS, Aug. 10 (UPI)—The Vietcong, in its first appeal to President Ford, demanded today that the United States cease all aid to the Saigon administration.

The Vietcong delegation to the recessed Paris peace talks with South Vietnam issued a declaration saying: "To end the war and re-establish peace, the United States must put an end to all military engagements and all interference in the interior affairs of South Vietnam, to cease all aid to the bellicose group of [President] Nguyen Van Thieu and to scrupulously respect the Paris treaty on Vietnam."
