General William Westmoreland, former U.S. military commander in Vietnam, said yesterday that President Ford should be given authority to launch B-52 raids in Indochina and mine the Haiphong harbor.

He recommended that Mr. Ford be authorized, presumably by Congress, "to use tactical air, B-52 strikes to hit the Communist supply lines, all of which have been set up in violation of the Paris cease—fire accords."....
