Ex-POW Takes

Teaching Job At High School

RICHMOND, Aug. 26 (AP)—Navy Lt. Cdr. Paul Galanti, who was a prisoner of war in North Vietnam for seven years, will become assistant commandant of cadets at Benedictine High School here next month.

Officials of the Roman Catholic school said Galanti will serve as a leadership counselor and will teach a course in "positive thinking" for seniors.

Galanti has been a Navy recruiter since returning to Richmond from Vietnam and now is working toward a master of commerce degree at the University of Richmond, attending classes mainly at night.

"I feel the goals of Benedictine regarding moral values and inner strength are consistent with the ideals that enabled the American POWs of the Vietnam crisis to regain their sanity and return with heads held high," he said in a statement.

Galanti is a 1962 graduate of the Naval Academy at Annapolis.
