

TIMES CASE HEARD; RESTRAINT EXTENDED;
U.S. ACTION HALTS A BOSTON GLOBE SERIES

The United States Court of Appeals here heard arguments yesterday on the Government's effort to enjoin The New York Times from publishing secret information on the Vietnam war. A prompt decision was promised.

The Court continued in effect the temporary restraining order that has blocked further publication of material drawn from a Pentagon study of how the United States became involved in Vietnam.

At about the same time the Federal Court of Appeals in Washington heard arguments in a similar suit by the Justice Department to enjoin The Washington Post from publishing articles based on parts of the Pentagon study. Pending decision the court continued the temporary restraining order that had been issued against The Post.
