

President Again Endorses

Sonnenfeldt for Treasury

(UPI) — President Nixon has the "greatest respect" for Helmut Sonnenfeldt and hopes he will be confirmed as Treasury Under Secretary, the White House said today.

Mr. Nixon selected Mr. Sonnenfeldt four months ago, but his nomination has been held up by Representative John M. Ashbrook, Republican of Ohio, who said he wanted to investigate whether Mr. Sonnenfeldt was "a security risk."

Mr. Sonnenfeldt now works with the National Security Council under Henry A. Kissinger, Mr. Nixon's foreign affairs adviser.
