Move to Drop Charges in Drug Raid

The Justice Department asked a federal judge yesterday to drop remaining charges against five federal narcotics agents acquitted of violating the civil rights of persons involved in the Collinsville, Ill., drug raids last year.

In a motion filed in U.S. District Court in Alton, Ill., the department also asked dismissal of charges against one other federal agemt and one other local officer whose trials were pending on charges in connection with the raids.
