

### Some Newsmen Subpoenas Criticized by Nixon Aide

CHICAGO, April 7 (UPI)—President Nixon's director of communications said today he thought the Justice Department was wrong on some occasions when newsmen have been subpoenaed to reveal unpublished information or sources.

Herbert G. Klein told the National Association of Broadcasters there were certain grounds on which the Government can go too far and endanger the sources of the newsmen.

"On some occasions, I think the Justice Department has been wrong," he said.
