Oakland Funeral Saturday for George Jackson

Funeral services for George Jackson, 29, slain in San Quentin's abortive prison break, will be held on Saturday, it was announced yesterday.

They will be held at 11 a.m. at St. Augustine's Episcopal Church at 2624 West street, Oakland, where a year ago last rites were held for his 17-year-old brother, Jonathan, slain in the attempt to free prisoners at the Marin County Civic Center.

Jackson, a native of Chicago who was taken to Southern California as a child, is survived by his parents, Mr. and Mrs. Lester Jackson of Pasadena, and three sisters.

Funeral arrangements are being handled by the Thompson Funeral Home, 9900 East 14th street, Oakland. Jackson will be buried next to his brother in Mount Vernon, Ill.
