Rally Here Hits Death Of Jackson

A racially mixed group of about 125 persons marched from Alamo Square eight blocks to Duboce Park yesterday afternoon where they held a rally to protest the death of George Jackson and alleged racism in the California prison system.

The march was sponsored by the Progressive Labor Party, Students for a Democratic Society, and the Challenge Corps. Speakers condemned the killing of George Jackson and charged i nmates in California prisons are being subjected to racist brutality by officials.

At its peak the marchers, about evenly mixed between blacks and whites, stretched a half block. The march and rally at Duboce Park were peaceful. The crowd was watched by four police patrol cars including members of the tactical squad.
