> He is being held in a specially-constructed cell, detached from the older quarters, and no one sees him, serves him his food, exercizes supervision over him except Warden Hocker and certain specially designated employes.

"These conditions will prevail until California needs him," said Hocker yesterday. "We don't have revolutionaries here and we don't plan to accommodate such activities on our reservation.

"If there are political activists they keep pretty quiet about it and that's all right with me . . . just as long as they keep it a total secret and do their time decently."

Hocker clearly means what he says. A former captain at San Quentin, he is a calm, serene, unflappable man who has built a reputation for no-nonsense prison management.
