

Mother Asks UN Probe of Jackson Death

The mother of slain Soledad Brother George Jackson said yesterday she will ask the United Nations to investigate the death of her son during an outbreak of violence at San Quentin Aug. 21.

Mrs. Georgia Jackson said she would also ask the UN to investigate and "protect the rights" of prisoners in what she called "the barbarous penal institutions of the State of California."

Jackson, 29, was killed by a guard in what prison officials said was an abortive escape attempt. Mrs. Jackson said her son was murdered.
