

'Q' Inmate Beaten to Death

A 25 year old San Quentin inmate — transferred from a Northern California honor camp only a month ago — was bludgeoned to death with a stool by another prisoner yesterday.

Henry Allen Pinkard died at the prison hospital 11 hours after the other inmate, whose identity officials refused to disclose, allegedly hit him on the head with the stool during an argument. The men, both blacks, were working in the honor ranch outside the prison.

John Apostol, in command of the prison early today, said Pinkard, who was convicted of attempted robbery — a first offense — in Alameda County in 1968, was considered a good inmate.
