## Quentin Con Near Parole Killed in Fight

A 25-year-old San Quentin Prison inmate scheduled for parole in three months died late Sunday in the prison hospital after a fight with another inmate, authorities said yesterday.

Officials said Henry A. Pinkard, serving time since 1968 for an attempted robbery, suffered severe head injuries after being clubbed with a stool.

A suspect is being held in connection with the attack, which took place in the prison's pre-release center, a minimum security area beyond the prison walls, officials said.

Both the victim and his suspected assailant are black, the officials said.
