

Convict Near End of Sentence Kills Himself

San Quentin authorities said an inmate with less than a month to go before being discharged apparently committed suicide in his cell early yesterday.

The body of Albert Sianez, 38, a convicted Los Angeles burglar, was discovered by a guard about 4 a.m. yesterday, authorities said. Sianez had apparently hanged himself with a bed sheet attached to a shelf in his cell.

Sianez first came to San Quentin 15 years ago for second degree burglary. He was released on parole twice, authorities said, but violated conditions of his parole both times.

On November 7 he would have served the full 15-year maximum sentence imposed on him.
