"It got me so down, I didn't believe it," said Jim Rowney of Mountain View, Calif., one of the paroled convicts. "I just couldn't take it and broke down.

The experiment was supposed to last two weeks, with the guards working 8 to 10 hour shifts and the prisoners locked up fulltime in the makeshift prison.
