**2 Quentin Cons**  
**Indicted in**  
**Guard's Slaying**

Murder indictments were returned Tuesday night by the Marin county Grand Jury against two San Quentin Prison inmates in connection with the fatal stabbing last July 19 of correctional officer Leo G. Davis.

The two are Earl Gibson, 28, serving a life term for first degree burglary, and Larry Justice, 28, convicted for grand theft and two felonious assaults. Both are from Los Angeles.

Justice has also been charged with the stabbing of Herman Earl Johnson, 25, who had testified in a Soledad Prison slaying case early this year. Davis was guarding Johnson in the San Quentin hospital when he was stabbed to death.
