

Santa Clara Security for Angela Trial

The Santa Clara county Board of Supervisors authorized an initial expenditure of \$203,600 yesterday to increase security for the forthcoming Angela Davis trial.

The money will be used to hire 24 additional sheriff's deputies, five matrons and a clerk, and will also be used to purchase two metal detectors.

Trial of Miss Davis, the black militant charged with murder, kidnaping and conspiracy in the Marin Civic Center shootings last year, was ordered transferred from Marin county to Santa Clara county on December 1.
