Angela Backer Loses Case

Fresno rancher Rodger McAfee, who posted most of the \$102,500 bail for Angela Davis, must pay \$3531 plus interest to a San Francisco architect who worked on plans for a \$12.5 million development that never materialized.

The decision was handed

down yesterday by Municipal Judge Harry W. Low who heard the case last week.

Architect Robert Batchelor sued McAfee, claiming his staff put in 151 hours of work for a housing and commercial development on 56 acres near Fresno State Col-

lege.

Batchelor said he himself worked 47 hours and neither he nor his staff received any compensation.

Judge Low awarded Batchelor not only the \$3531 but 7 percent interest from July 1, 1966, amounting to more than \$1000.
