## A San Quentin Inmate Knifed In the Back

A 26-year-old San Quentin inmate was stabbed in the back with a prison-made knife while he was on the way to breakfast yesterday.

Louis Valenzuela, serving a one year - to - life sentence from Los Angeles county of a lewd and lascivious conduct conviction, was reported in satisfactory condition at the prison hospital, with a six-inch wound.

Prison spokesmen said a crude knife was discovered in the rotunda area near the east cell block where the stabbing occurred shortly before 6 a.m. There were no suspects.

It was the fourth knifing incident this year at San Quentin.
