Magee Again Vetoes Lawyer

Ruchell Magee, a black San Quentin convict charged in the Aug. 7, 1970, Marin Civic Center shootout, wants his white court-appointed attorney fired as "a racism combination with the attorney general of California to keep the defendant in a bind."

A penciled petition, received by mail and filed today in Marin County Superi-

or Court, sought the discharge of attorney Robert Carrow of Novato.

Magee got Carrow removed as his counsel but later, after Magee won the right to represent himself, Carrow was reinstated as co-counsel.

Magee's letter charged that Carrow was involved in an "illegitimate defense committee for Ruchell Magee . . .

with specific intent to defraud the public of U.S. Monies."

It also accused him of being allied with the state attorney general to deprive him of his constitutional right to call witnesses.

Tomorrow visiting Tulare County Superior Judge Leonard Ginsburg is scheduled to hear Magee's motion for a change of venue.
