Magee's

Trial Moved

From Marin

Ruchell Magee, who is charged with the murder, kidnaping and conspiracy in the August 7, 1970 shootings at the Marin Civic Center, was granted a change of venue from Marin county yesterday.

Visiting Superior Court Judge Leonard M. Ginsberg of Tulare county allowed the trial to be moved after the prosecutor, assistant state attorney general Eric Collins, made no objections.

New site of the trial has not yet been determined.

Angela Davis, with whom Magee was originally to have gone to trial for the same incident, had her case severed from Magee's and moved to Santa Clara county last year.

Just down the hall from the proceedings in the Magee case, Marin Superior Court Judge Joseph G. Wilson halted a pre-trial hearing on the cases of six San Quentin inmates charged with murder and conspiracy in the San Quentin Prison riot of Aug. 21, 1971, in which three guards, George Jackson and two other inmates were killed.

The hearing was adjourned until June 15 after defendant David Johnson spat in Judge Wilson's face during a tense moment.

"Let the record reflect," Judge Wilson said on adjourning, "that he spat accurately."
