Con Sentenced

In Killing of

Soledad Prison inmate Hugo A. Pinell, accused in the alleged escape attempt at San Quentin Prison last August, was sentenced here yesterday for the killing of a Soledad guard a year before the San Quentin incident.

Pinell, 27, was sentenced to 15 years in prison on his conviction for voluntary manslaughter in the stabbing death of guard Robert J. McCarthy.

Superior Court Judge Elmer Machado said Pinell must serve the sentence after completing an earlier term of three years to life for rape in connection with an attack on a University of California coed in San Francisco in 1965.
