## ***\$884,000 Price Tag Put On the Angela Trial***

SAN JOSE — Santa Clara County thus far has spent \$884,677 on the Angela Davis murder - kidnap - conspiracy trial, it was reported today.

County Executive Howard Campen told the Board of Supervisors in his annual budget message that the figure includes security measures and extra personnel hired by the sheriff's depart-

ment for the trial, now in its 14th week.

Among the security measures are a 12-foot high chain link fence around the entrance to the San Jose courthouse where the trial is being held, metal detectors and closed-circuit television network.

Extensive remodeling also was done on the nearby jail where Miss Davis was to

have been housed. However, the State Supreme Court's banning of the death penalty led to her release on bail before the trial started.

The Legislature earlier this year passed a bill shifting the trial costs to the State Department of Corrections. However, the county will have to get a special appropriation from the state for reimbursement.
