Farmer Hopes Angela Will Visit

FRESNO — (AP) — The prosperous, pro-Communist farmer who put up the collateral for Angela Davis' bail said yesterday he hoped the black militant would visit his family soon and "relax for a few days" to recuperate from her murder-kidnap-conspiracy trial.

"We're celebrating joyously here today," said Rodger McAfee, 33, who operates a 1100-acre farm and 84-cow dairy 17 miles southeast of Fresno.

McAfee pledged 405 acres of his farm land, worth \$330,000, as collateral for Miss Davis' \$102,500 bond Feb. 23, setting her free from the Santa Clara County Jail, where she had been waiting trial.

When he posted collateral, McAfee said he hoped the Communist Party would make him a member someday.

"We hope Angela will be down shortly and stay with us and relax for a few days," McAfee, the father of four boys, said Sunday.

"Once again our faith in jurisprudence has been jus-

tified in this acquittal of Angela Davis," he added. "I feel it's going to be a touchstone for America for a long time to come and I hope forever we will not persecute people for political beliefs or because of race or national origin."
