

Carr Venue Plea Loses

SAN JOSE — A change of venue has been denied the two accused assassins of James E. Carr, former cell-mate of George Jackson.

Superior Court Judge James B. Scott yesterday ruled that pre-trial publicity would not prejudice a fair trial for Richard Rodriguez, 22, of Baldwin Park and Lamar Lloyd Mims, 21, of Los Angeles.

The two are accused of the execution-style slaying of

Carr on April 6 while the Angela Davis trial was in progress here.

Carr, a 28-year-old ex-convict, was slain in a barrage of gunfire at the back-

door of the home of his mother-in-law, Joan Hammer, a woman who had been active in the movement to free Jackson and the other Soledad Brothers.
