Court Ordered

To Hear Appeal

The California Supreme Court yesterday ordered a lower court to start processing an appeal by convict Ruchell Magee.

Magee had pleaded guilty nearly one year ago to charges of aggravated kidnaping. He was sentenced to life in prison January 23 by San Jose Superior Court Judge William Ingram.

After he had pleaded guilty he tried to withdraw the plea, but the judge wouldn't let him. He then appealed to the Supreme Court, which yesterday told Ingram to process the appeal.
