**Netherlands Hunt Goes On
For Missing U.S. Pathologist**

AMSTERDAM, The Netherlands, Dec. 13 (Reuters)—The police said today that there was still no trace of Dr. Richard H. Follis of Washington, a pathologist, eight days after his disappearance here, but a spokesman said a search was still going on.

Yesterday the police thought they had solved the mystery when a man's body was found floating in a canal. But the body turned out to be that of a 90-year-old man missing for a month.

WASHINGTON, Dec. 13 (UPI)—The State Department today discounted hints in the European press that Dr. Follis had been involved with the Central Intelligence Agency. "I would have no reason to suspect that he was," Robert J. McCloskey, State Department press officer said when asked to comment.
