

No Report on Jordan's Death

The State Department said yesterday it is still waiting for a full report from the Czech government on the death of Charles H. Jordan, the Jewish relief official whose body was found this week in the Vltava river in Prague.

A department spokesman said the United States was awaiting the results of a Czech police investigation and the results of a test of Jordan's body tissue being conducted in Switzerland in an effort to determine whether Jordan drowned or died from other causes.
