Washington, Feb. 13 (AP)- Intelligence chief John A. McCone said max today that "Lee Oswald was never directly or indirectly liked with the CIA."

McCone's statement, through a Central Intelligence Agency spokesman, was prompted by Mrs. Margaret Oswald's expressed belief that he son was a CIA secret agent "set up to take the blame" for President John F. Kennedy's assassination.

Mrs. Oswald made this suggestion yesterday as she finished three days of testimony to the presidential commission investigating the Kennedy assassination.

The commission may call one or possibly two new witnesses next week.
