

Senate C.I.A. Study Urged

WASHINGTON, Nov. 5 (UPI) — Senator Eugene J. McCarthy, Democratic of Minnesota, called today for creation of a special Senate committee to check on the Central Intelligence Agency. He said he planned to introduce a resolution next year to set up a nine-man Select Committee on Foreign Intelligence to conduct a year-long review of C.I.A. operations and report to the 90th Congress in 1967.
