

Fulbright Defers Reporting Of Measure on C.I.A. Panel

WASHINGTON, June 22 —

Senator J. W. Fulbright, Democrat of Arkansas who is chairman of the Foreign Relations Committee, postponed today the reporting of a bill that would put three members from his panel on the committee supervising activities of the Central Intelligence Agency.

Senator Mike Mansfield of Montana, the majority leader, said yesterday that the bill and the committee report would be filed today. This timetable had apparently not been cleared with all interested parties.

Mr. Mansfield said he still expected the bill to be reported in time for floor action the second week of July.
