..... What is the truth about the curious episode of the "hi-jacked" American ship which is said to have been the means used by the C.I.A. to get arms into the hands of Lon Nol as the prelude to the coup?

Story in SFChronicle 5 May 70 (no source given) says Cambodian authorities returned the ship and "her cargo" of napalm bombs to the U.S. Wording implies entire cargo consisted of napalm bombs; story does not say whether other arms were also carried.
