## S. Aides Confirm Drive by Laotians

VIENTIANE, Laos, July 9-United States officials, acknowledging for the first time that a new sweep was under way on the Plaine des Jarres, reported today that Americanbacked Laotian commandos were in control of two-thirds of the plain area.

The officials, who had previously refused to confirm reports of the operation, said the objective was to destroy Communist supplies, not to occupy the plain. Reports of the operation had been circulating since Wednesday
