From report by Clifton Daniel on Nixon news conference 31 Jan 73:

.... Not only did he remember the last name of one of five [?] American prisoners held in China - John T.

Downey - but he was also able to recall the length of his sentence - 30 years, commuted to five. He also knew, and said for the first time, that Mr. Downey was an agent of the Central Intelligence Agency. (Question 15.)
