The present CIA director, Richard Helms, was questioned about his reaction to orders from presidential staff aides. Bubert Humphrey specifically asked why the CIA provided disguises to Howard Hunt at the instistence of White House aides:

Numphrey (voice): When you get a request from a White House staff member, Mr. Helms -- you've had them over the years -- what is the presumption of that request as to the basis of authority?

Helms (voice): The presumption is that it comes from

the President.

Humphrey: That would be particularly true of the

chief of staff ?

Helms: Yes sir.

Helms testified nobody dreamed the White House would use CIA disguises in criminal activity.
