- Pope Paul VI, who canceled his general audience Wednesday, is feeling better and celebrated Mass in his private chapel. He is suffering a recurrence of arthrosis in his right knee.

- The remains of U.S. Vice Consul John Patterson—found dead Sunday in the northern Mexican desert nearly four months after his abduction—will be flown to Washington, the U.S. embassy in Mexico City announced.

- The Panama Canal Co. has increased its tolls for ships using the waterway by 19.7 per cent, the first increase in its 60-year history, a company spokesman said.

- The East-West troop-cut talks in Vienna are to recess next week for two months, and the European security conference being held in Geneva has scheduled a five-week recess beginning July 26.

- The Ethiopian armed forces arrested five more leading Ethiopians separately from the list of 27 wanted men they published last Saturday.

- A court in Adana, Turkey, dropped smuggling charges against five U.S. Air Force noncommissioned officers and five American civilian employees at the U.S. Air Force Base in Incirlik.
