The Inter-American Press Association, in a rare criticism of the United States, yesterday condemned the Central Intelligence Agency for financing Chilean newspapers opposed to the late President Salvador Allende.

"Those who give money for improper acts are as guilty as those who receive it," the association's report or freedom of the press said."

CIA financing of Chilean newspapers was first disclosed last month by CIA Director William Colby in leaked congressional testimony and later confirmed by President Ford.

The association report also condemned earlier revelations that the CIA had paid accredited journalists for spying in various countries.
