A former NSC staff member and onetime White House aide to Henry A. Kissinger, Halpe-rin said the information had been denied him despite for-mal requests under the strengthened Freed formation Act that went into effect Feb. 19.

The litigation was initiated as part of a project sponsored jointly by the nonprofit Cen-ter for National Security Stud-ies here—with which Halperin is affiliated—and the Ameri-can Civil Liberties Union. "The future establishment of subordinate domestic bases is envisioned," Richard Helms, then-deputy director for CIA plans, said in the Feb. 11, 1963, memorandum.
