Anti-U.S. Rally in Zaire

Kinshasa, Zaire

Thousands of persons demonstrated in front of the United States cultural center here yesterday in the wake of an abortive coup a few days ago against President Mobutu Sese Seko, the Zaire news agency AZAP reported.

The demonstration, which the agency said took place without incident, followed newspaper allegations, denied by Washington, that the United States backed the coup.

AZAP said the crowd earlier marched through Kinshasa to express support for Mobutu.

The agency quoted the Kinshasa daily newspaper Salongo as saying that three army generals, a colonel and two majors were the chief comspirators.

Salongo said that the chief

plotter was 39-year-old Brigadier General Fallu Sambu, who was military attache at the Zaire embassy in Washington until earlier this month.
