## Smoking Out Hughes

A New York City Supreme Court justice has given billionaire **Howard Hughes** two weeks to prove he's not dead.

Justice Bernard Nadel issued a show-cause order directing Hughes to state why he should not be declared legally dead. "I think we're going to smoke him out," said Manhattan attorney I. Walton Bader, who obtained the order on behalf of Victor Kurtz, a stockholder in Air West, a California

airline acquired by the Hughes empire in 1969.

Kurtz brought a \$100-million classaction suit against Hughes in July in

State Supreme Court charging him with stock manipulation and fraud. But Bader said he later received a letter from lawyers for Hughes' firms,

who were served the complaint, saying they did not represent Hughes personally but only Hughes' corporations.
