LOS ANGELES (UPI)—William Richard (Dick) Hannah, . 60, long a spokesman for billionaire Howard Hughes' Summa Corp., died at his home Thursday. (S) JAN Mr. 'Hannah underwent open-heart surgery last July

open-heart surgery last July 15 and never returned to work as a vice president of Carl Byoir, the international public

relations firm.

For the last two decades,
Mr. Hannah's primary
responsibility for Byoir was as spokesman for Hughes' interests. He was the only official contact for representatives of the news media seeking answers to questions of Hughes' whereabouts and attitudes on various litigations.

More often than not, Mr. Hannah's answer was a "no comment" but he was unfailingly cheerful even when contacted during the middle of the night.

A native of Glendale, Calif.,
Mr. Hannah was a writer and
editor for the old Hollywood
Citizen-News, the Los Angeles
Examiner, and the Los
Angeles Times before joining
the public relations firm.
During World War II, he was a
combat correspondent with
the U.S. Marine Corps.
Survivors include his wife,
Vicki, and a sister.
