## Howard Hughes In Acapulco, Paper Reports

FREEPORT, Bahamas, Feb. 12 (AP) — Howard Hughes, who has reportedly been living on the top floor of a hotel here since 1973, left for Acapulco, Mexico, early Wednesday with 20 or 30 of his aides, the Freeport News said.

Perry Lieber, a spokesman for Hughes' Summa Corp., said in Las Vegas that he does not know whether the 70-year-old reclusive billionaire moved to Acapulco. If he has moved, Lieber said, Summa was not notified.
