Former agent Agee wants in from the cold

THE HAGUE (AP) — Former CIA agent Philip Agee has told the Aliens Department that he and his family want to settle permanently in The Netherlands, the Justice Ministry said.

A ministry spokesman said the request was under study.

The 41-year-old American, author of a controversial book detailing CIA activities, was expelled by Britain as a security risk in June. Last week he was arrested and expelled by France.
