
Germany To Expel Agee

Former CIA agent Philip Agee was detained by police when he arrived at Hamburg airport yesterday and ordered to leave West Germany on the first flight this morning.

He has been listed by West German authorities as an "unwanted person," a police spokesman said.

Agee arrived here from Holland where he is appealing a Dutch government decision to deport him.

Author of the book "Inside the Company — a CIA Diary", the 42-year-old American was expelled from Britain earlier this year after being declared a security risk.
